- a. Choose your favorite animal in each vertebrate classification. (mammal, reptile, fish, amphibian, bird)

- c. Use the facts you have gathered to complete a resumé, an example has been provided for you.
- d. Find a picture of your vertebrate and attach to the resumé.

Each resume should include the following:

- Scientific and Common name of vertebrate
- A nickname (any personal name you want to give your animal)
- Year of Birth (Optional)
- Age (Optional)
- Address: Describe the vertebrate's habitat.
- A personal description: size, physical characteristics (at LEAST 3), and feeding habits.
- Job Goal: What job are you requesting? Your job should be within the characteristics of your chosen animal.
 - Example: If you choose a panda, it should not have a job about flying
